The 37m/121'5" 'Mayama' motor yacht built by shipyard Couach. This yacht features interior styling by Danièle Chopard. Built in 2010, She offers guest accommodation for up to 12 guests with a layout comprising a master suite, two double cabins and two twin cabins. There are 7 beds in total, including 2 pullmans. She is also capable of carrying up to 5 crew onboard. Built with a GRP hull and GRP superstructure, she benefits from a semi-displacement hull to provide exceptional seakeeping and impressive speeds. Powered by twin MTU engines, she comfortably cruises at 24 knots, reaches a maximum speed of 30 knots with a range of up to 440 nautical miles from her 17,000 litre fuel tanks at cruising speed. An advanced stabilisation system on board reduces the side-to-side roll of the yacht and promises guests exceptional comfort levels at anchor or when underway
